




Cupid's Arrow







FAQ

DO I NEED A PERMIT?

Yes. All wedding ceremonies require a location permit. Stradbroke Island Events prefers to manage the permit booking to ensure the correct booking timings and locations are reserved. SIE requests that clients forward a copy of their permit should they have secured the document from Redland City Council.

CAN I HAVE CONFETTI?

Fresh or dried petals and leaves are permitted. While eco-confetti is advertised as biodegradable it takes time to breakdown and therefore looks like litter left on the beach and can confuse well meaning community members,

WEATHER CONDITIONS?

SIE recommends a wet-weather location is nominated/booked by clients. The reception venue is usually the best back-up plan. Clients should speak with reception venue management to ensure this option is available. Please be aware that all beach ceremony locations can be affected by tides, lagoons & debris. SIE will let you know if your chosen location is affected.

If wind level at the ceremony site is uncomfortable, SIE will consider and discuss (on the day) the option of relocating the ceremony (pending availability). SIE regularly reviews the weather forecast in the lead up to events and is well equipped to make the final location decision (in consultation with clients) no later than four hours prior to guest arrival. Many couples proceed with their original plan regardless of weather conditions. Please note that some ceremony items cannot be used if rain arrives, eg. jute aisle runners, parasols, cushions and

sound equipment.

SHOULD WE REHEARSE?

A rehearsal is optional. SIE recommends clients organise a rehearsal with/without their celebrant so all parties are aware of the ceremony space. A rehearsal does contribute to managing nerves on the day. Locally-based celebrants offer their attendance at rehearsals as part of their package.

CAN WE HAVE DRINKS?

Under Queensland law, consumption of alcohol in a public place is prohibited without the appropriate liquor license. Stradbroke Island Events' mobile liquor license is extended to clients purchasing a ceremony package. To conform to legislative requirements, clients wishing to serve alcoholic beverages at their ceremony on a beach or headland, are obligated to purchase alcohol from SIE. Clients can specify type/brands of beverage to be available up to 60 days prior to the event. SIE can recommend amounts based on guest numbers. If drinks are involved you can add another hour if required.

In accordance with Queensland legislation, responsible service of alcohol will be strictly adhered to and therefore all alcohol is to be served by Stradbroke Island Events staff. See https:/www.business.qld.gov.au/industries/hospitality-tourism-sport/liquor-gaming/liquor

BYO alcohol isn't permitted in beach/headland events.

HOW LONG DOES A CEREMONY USUALLY TAKE?

SIE allocates 90 minutes for a ceremony. Guests generally arrive thirty minutes prior to the start time. The ceremony takes approximately thirty minutes and it is recommended to allow thirty minutes for onsite photos with family and friends.



IS THE BEACH/RESERVE OPEN TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC?

All bookable ceremony locations are public spaces, therefore holding a permit doesn't exclude the public accessing the area. Most people are respectful and keep a distance from ceremonies.

DO I NEED TO PAY A SECURITY BOND?

Yes. A security bond of \$500 is required on all ceremony bookings. Subject to breakages, damages or breaches of SIE's Terms and Conditions, this amount will be refunded within fourteen days of the event.

CAN I SUPPLY MY OWN FLORAL ARRANGEMENTS?

Yes. Florists booked by clients can deliver and install floral arrangements on site or can arrange to deliver florals to the SIE office for us to install on the day. SIE recommends clients keep us informed of the arrangements made for the supply of florals and the intended locations.

I AM READY TO BOOK A PACKAGE BUT AM UNSURE OF MY PREFERRED STYLE.

To secure their preferred location on their preferred date (as well as SIE services), clients are encouraged to book early. Styling decisions can be made during the planning process and additional items can always be added (up to one month prior to the event date).

IS IT POSSIBLE TO SUPPLY MY OWN STYLING ITEMS?

Yes. Please advise the SIE team of the items you wish to supply, who will be delivering, installing and collecting them. Minimum install requirements will not incur additional fees however if complex installation is requested additional fees my occur.

I WANT TO HIRE ITEMS NOT BOOK A PACKAGE. IS THIS POSSIBLE?

Yes. SIE can deliver and collect hired items for your family/friends to install the equipment. The minimum equipment hire spend is \$300 excluding delivery. Please note that some of the ceremony items require SIE installation. In these cases, an additional fee will be incurred.

CAN CHANGES BE MADE TO THE PACKAGE PURCHASED?

Once a package is booked through the payment of a deposit, changes with SIE can be made up to one month out from the event date. No further deductions are possible after this date.

To preserve the natural environment on North Stradbroke Island, we ask that balloons, rice, confetti, single use plastic bottles and plastic straws are not used.

PAYMENTS

Paying your 25% deposit locks in your date, permits, venue, our services and products. SIE will send you a Quarterly payment plan from initial deposit to 1 month out form your event date. SIE will send you reminders with payments are due.
